

5555 (45%) - completed analysis

3247 (26%) - at laboratory awaiting analysis

3572 (29%) - need additional analysis

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Investigation Results

866/870 Investigations have been initiated:

176/161 Investigations remain active: 18%

690/709 Investigations are closed: 81%

104/106 Individuals were identified that had been previously convicted of the crime: 15%

142/143 Requests for indictments have been completed against persons or DNA profiles: 16%

- 94/95 named suspects (36 multi case suspects) 66% of indictments
- 48/48 John Does (2 suspects on one case) 34% of indictments
 - 25/25 John Does are now named (7 multi case suspects) 52% of John Does
 - 1 Named John Doe is deceased

62/64 victims/suspects are deceased: 9%

- 10/10 suspects (does not include the deceased John Doe) 1%
- 52/54 victims: 8%

103/107 victims declined to participate: 15%

27/27 unable to locate victim: 4%

154/160 cases past the statute of limitations: 23%

11/13 prosecution declined: 2%

26/26 insufficient/degraded DNA: 4%

23/24 cases no crime occurred: 3%

39/40 consensual partner: 6%
