

#### Investigation Results

#### 681/720 Investigations have been initiated: 185/173 Investigations remain active: 24% 496/547 Investigations are closed: 76%

- 83/87 Individuals were identified that had been previously convicted of the crime: 16%
- 117/125 Requests for indictments have been completed against persons or DNA profiles: 23%
  - 73/**79** named suspects (31 multi case suspects) 63% of indictments
  - 44/46 John Does (2 suspects on one case) 37% of indictments
    - 12/12 John Does are now named (7 multi case suspects) 26% of John Does
    - 1 Named John Doe is deceased

52/53 victims/suspects are deceased: 10%

- 9/9 suspects (does not include the deceased John Doe) 2%
- 43/44 victims: 8%
- 72/82 victims declined to participate: 15%
- 17/19 unable to locate victim: 3%
- 92/101 cases past the statute of limitations: 18%
- 1/2 prosecution declined: 0%
- 25/25 insufficient/degraded DNA: 5%
- 14/20 cases no crime occurred: 4%
- 24/31 consensual partner: 6%
