

~	Test every kit in our inventory that is need of additional forensic testing	Progress: Shipping and testing continues
~	Investigate leads and examine all cases coming from testing of those kits	<u>Progress:</u> New investigations initiated every month. New indictments requested every month. MPD has a full time unit devoted to this project.
~		<b>Progress:</b> SOP is reviewed and input is sought from Rape Crisis Center, Joyful Heart Foundation, and our national partners to make sure our efforts are victim centered.
~	Prosecute to the fullest extent of the law individuals who are identified as suspects resulting from this additional forensic testing	<b>Progress:</b> Complete thorough investigations and present requests for indictments to the Shelby County District Attorney General on all cases that can be prosecuted. All cases that cannot be prosecuted are reviewed by SAK Working Group team members to make sure everyone is in agreement on prosecution of the case.

# **Investigation Results MTD**

# 3682/3761 Investigations have been initiated: 254/247 Investigations remain active: 7% 3428/3514 Investigations are closed: 93%

- **591/600** Individuals were identified that had been previously convicted of the crime: **17%**
- 424/435 Requests for indictments have been completed against persons or DNA profiles: 12%
  - 252/257 named suspects (52 multi case suspects) 59% of indictments
  - 172/178 John Does (2 suspects on one case) 41% of indictments
    - 38/42 John Does are now named (8 multi case suspects) 24% of John Does
    - 1 Named John Doe is deceased

377/385 victims/suspects are deceased: 11%

- 135/136 suspects (does not include the deceased John Doe) 4%
- 242/249 victims: 7%

289/289 victims declined to participate: 8%

24/25 unable to locate victim: 1%

679/692 cases past the statute of limitations: 20%

- 278/300 prosecution declined: 9%
- 382/382 insufficient/degraded DNA: 11%
- 72/74 cases no crime occurred: 2%
- 92/100 consensual partner: 3%


## **Prosecution Results**

Rape: 4 assaults between Aug. 1989 and Jul. 1990

- The suspect would enter the victims residence at night
- The suspect would rape the victim and demand money
- April 2017 a CODIS hit came back to Tony White
- November 2017 he was indicted for the crimes

On 3/27/2019, he plead guilty to 3 counts of aggravated rape-20 years each and one count of rape-10 years. He was placed on the Sex Offender Registry and will have Community Supervision for Life.
