

#### Investigation Results

# 1209/1417 Investigations have been initiated: 198/298 Investigations remain active: 21% 1009/1119 Investigations are closed: 79%

**132/144** Individuals were identified that had been previously convicted of the crime: **13%** 188/200 Requests for indictments have been completed against persons or DNA profiles: **18%** 

- 127/133 named suspects (45 multi case suspects) 67% of indictments
- 61/67 John Does (2 suspects on one case) 33% of indictments
  - 24/27 John Does are now named (7 multi case suspects) 40% of John Does
  - 1 Named John Doe is deceased

99/113 victims/suspects are deceased: 10%

- 21/24 suspects (does not include the deceased John Doe) 2%
- 78/89 victims: 8%
- 143/151 victims declined to participate: 13%
- 33/33 unable to locate victim: 3%
- 242/269 cases past the statute of limitations: 24%
- 44/48 prosecution declined: 4%
- 52/77 insufficient/degraded DNA: 7%
- 32/35 cases no crime occurred: 3%
- 43/46 consensual partner: 4%


