
Status of Mayor Strickland's Executive Order

(60%) completed analysis



Investigation Results MTD

1695/1728 Investigations have been initiated:

409/385 Investigations remain active: 22%

1286/1343 Investigations are closed: 78%

182/193 Individuals were identified that had been previously convicted of the crime: 14%

213/214 Requests for indictments have been completed against persons or DNA profiles: 16%

- 138/138 named suspects (45 multi case suspects) 65% of indictments
- 75/76 John Does (2 suspects on one case) 35% of indictments
 - 27/27 John Does are now named (7 multi case suspects) 36% of John Does
 - 1 Named John Doe is deceased

- 96/97 victims: 7%

161/161 victims declined to participate: 12%

Jacquet Moore

One conviction

- January, 2000
- Victim leaves night club and waits outside for a taxi
- When taxi doesn't show, victim begins walking when she is stopped by an unknown male in a car who forces her to get in the car (weapon implied)
- Suspect drove victim to a parking lot and raped the victim
- Suspect DNA entered into CODIS 9/23/2013
- CODIS Hit Jacquet Moore 11/8/2013
- Found GUILTY by jury in December 2016; one week before the not guilty verdict

One acquittal

- April, 2000
- Unknown male knocks on victim's door asking for a glass of water
- Victim agrees, and brings the man water outside
- Male forces himself in to her house, pulls out a gun and forces victim upstairs and rapes her all night
- Suspect DNA entered into CODIS 12/2/2014
- CODIS Hit Jacquet Moore 12/18/2014
- Found NOT GUILTY by jury in December 2016; one week after the guilty verdict
- 2 pending trials; one scheduled for May and one for June.



Prosecution Results

- Cases Pled Guilty= 9
 - Combined sentence of 109 years
 - One individual pled guilty to two cases. 40 year sentence
- Guilty at Trial=3
 - Combined sentence 41 years
- Not Guilty at Trial=1
- Set for Trial=11
- Pending in criminal court=139
- Prosecution declined prior to indictment=8
- Dismissed=7
- Defendant Deceased=1

- Sex Crimes Project Started May 16, 2016
- 33 Sex Crimes Defendants with devices
- 12 Sex Crimes Victims with devices
- DV Project started July 6, 2016
- Expanded September 6, 2016
- 161 DV Defendants with devices
- 20 DV Victims with devices
