

### Investigation Results MTD

# 2077/2165 Investigations have been initiated: 555/620 Investigations remain active: 27% 1522/1545 Investigations are closed: 73%

235/244 Individuals were identified that had been previously convicted of the crime: 15%
228/231 Requests for indictments have been completed against persons or DNA profiles: 15%

- 146/149 named suspects (48 multi case suspects) 64% of indictments
- 82/82 John Does (2 suspects on one case) 36% of indictments
  - 26/26 John Does are now named (7 multi case suspects) 32% of John Does
  - 1 Named John Doe is deceased

156/164 victims/suspects are deceased: 10%

- 45/48 suspects (does not include the deceased John Doe) 3%
- 111/116 victims: 7%

155/155 victims declined to participate: 10%

52/52 unable to locate victim: 3%

309/309 cases past the statute of limitations: 20%

- 95/96 prosecution declined: 6%
- 157/158 insufficient/degraded DNA: 10%
- 36/36 cases no crime occurred: 2%
- 48/48 consensual partner: 3%

#### Brandy Warren, 47

Pleaded guilty to AGGRAVATED ASSAULT 4/6/2017

**5 Year Sentence** 

Victim agreed to plea deal; did not want to go to trial



#### Rape: July, 2000

- While at a store, victim ran into a friend and 2 unknown males and spoke to them briefly.
- Victim left to go home and one unknown male followed her home and entered her house without her permission. He raped her
- CODIS hit came back to Brandy Warren in May, 2015
- Brandy Deshannor Warren was indicted for this crime in July, 2015
