

~	Test every kit in our inventory that is need of additional forensic testing	Progress: Shipping and testing continues
~	Investigate leads and examine all cases coming from testing of those kits	<u>Progress:</u> New investigations initiated every month. New indictments requested every month. MPD has a full time unit devoted to this project.
~		Progress: SOP is reviewed and input is sought from Rape Crisis Center, Joyful Heart Foundation, and our national partners to make sure our efforts are victim centered.
~	Prosecute to the fullest extent of the law individuals who are identified as suspects resulting from this additional forensic testing	Progress: Complete thorough investigations and present requests for indictments to the Shelby County District Attorney General on all cases that can be prosecuted. All cases that cannot be prosecuted are reviewed by SAK Working Group team members to make sure everyone is in agreement on prosecution of the case.
✓	Collaborate with, and participate in the national and state dialogue about best practices in in all areas related to matters of sexual assault;	<u>Progress:</u> SAK TF participates in national discussions and training through Summit for Cities Series, Joyful Heart Foundation, SAKI training, and the SAFER (Sexual Assault Facts, Education, and Response)

MSNM is meeting with small community groups at their location. MSNM is distributing awareness material to groups and coordinating a media campaign that includes radio and billboard advertisements.

Investigation Results MTD

2516/2577 Investigations have been initiated: 727/743 Investigations remain active: 29% 1789/1834 Investigations are closed: 71%

302/308 Individuals were identified that had been previously convicted of the crime: 17% 253/260 Requests for indictments have been completed against persons or DNA profiles: 14%

- 162/166 named suspects (51 multi case suspects) 64% of indictments
- 91/94 John Does (2 suspects on one case) 36% of indictments
 - 27/27 John Does are now named (8 multi case suspects) 29% of John Does
 - 1 Named John Doe is deceased

193/202 victims/suspects are deceased: 11%

- 54/59 suspects (does not include the deceased John Doe) 3%
- 139/143 victims: 8%

168/170 victims declined to participate: 9%

53/53 unable to locate victim: 3%

351/364 cases past the statute of limitations: 20%

119/119 prosecution declined: 7%

202/206 insufficient/degraded DNA: 11%

39/39 cases no crime occurred: 2%

52/52 consensual partner: 3%

Prosecution Results

4 Victims: September 2000 to May 2001

- A CODIS hit came back to Tony Sea January, 2012.
- Tony Sea was indicted for these crimes in January, 2013, November, 2013, May, 2014 and January, 2016.

On 10/18/2017, Tony Sea plead guilty to Rape.

40 Year Sentence @ 100%, SOR, Community Supervision for life All victims agreed to the plea.
