

~	Test every kit in our inventory that is need of additional forensic testing	Progress: Shipping and testing continues
~	Investigate leads and examine all cases coming from testing of those kits	<u>Progress:</u> New investigations initiated every month. New indictments requested every month. MPD has a full time unit devoted to this project.
~		<b>Progress:</b> SOP is reviewed and input is sought from Rape Crisis Center, Joyful Heart Foundation, and our national partners to make sure our efforts are victim centered.
~	Prosecute to the fullest extent of the law individuals who are identified as suspects resulting from this additional forensic testing	<b>Progress:</b> Complete thorough investigations and present requests for indictments to the Shelby County District Attorney General on all cases that can be prosecuted. All cases that cannot be prosecuted are reviewed by SAK Working Group team members to make sure everyone is in agreement on prosecution of the case.
✓	Collaborate with, and participate in the national and state dialogue about best practices in in all areas related to matters of sexual assault;	<u>Progress:</u> SAK TF participates in national discussions and training through Summit for Cities Series, Joyful Heart Foundation, SAKI training, and the SAFER (Sexual Assault Facts, Education, and Response)

# **Investigation Results MTD**

# 3417/3526 Investigations have been initiated: 395/386 Investigations remain active: 11% 3022/3140 Investigations are closed: 89%

- **511/527** Individuals were identified that had been previously convicted of the crime: **17% 385/403** Requests for indictments have been completed against persons or DNA profiles: **12%** 
  - 225/237 named suspects (51 multi case suspects) 59% of indictments
  - 160/166 John Does (2 suspects on one case) 41% of indictments
    - 38/38 John Does are now named (8 multi case suspects) 23% of John Does
    - 1 Named John Doe is deceased

346/357 victims/suspects are deceased: 11%

- 118/127 suspects (does not include the deceased John Doe) 4%
- **228/230** victims: 7%

269/275 victims declined to participate: 9%

23/23 unable to locate victim: 1%

592/617 cases past the statute of limitations: 20%

- 223/244 prosecution declined: 8%
- 358/363 insufficient/degraded DNA: 12%
- 63/65 cases no crime occurred: 2%
- 75/79 consensual partner: 3%

## **Prosecution Results**

Rape: March, 2003

- The victim willingly accepted a ride from the suspect
- The suspect drove the victim to an unknown location and raped her
- November 2015 a CODIS hit came back to Kevin Rose
- October 2017 Kevin Rose was indicted for this crime

On 11/17/2018, Kevin Rose plead guilty to Rape for 10 years at 100%. He was placed on the Sex Offender Registry and will have Community Supervision for Life.

The victim agreed to the plea
