A resolution to allocate and appropriate \$2,600,000 in City Council Community Grant funds to nonprofit agencies for FY22

- **WHEREAS**, the Memphis City Council desires to promote community programming and improve neighborhoods; and
- **WHEREAS**, the Tennessee Code Annotated § 6-64-111, empowers the Memphis City Council to appropriate funds for the financial aid of nonprofit organizations working to promote the general welfare of Memphis residents; and
- **WHEREAS,** nonprofit organizations and citizens work together to meet the needs of Memphians by extending the reach of City of Memphis services; and
- **WHEREAS**, the Memphis City Council recognizes nonprofit agencies as valued partners in the continuing efforts to improve the lives of Memphians; and
- **WHEREAS,** it is important to the members of the Memphis City Council to prioritize funding specialized programs congruent with the priorities of the City, which include addressing Crime and Drug Prevention, Youth Empowerment, Economic Development, and Poverty; and
- **WHEREAS**, each member gains the opportunity to individually allocate \$200,000 to ensure adequate grant awards amongst all City Council Districts; and
- **WHEREAS**, the Memphis City Council accepted and reviewed applications from more than 150 local nonprofit agencies and community partners; and
- **WHEREAS**, after selecting organizations and allocating funding during Budget Committee meetings, agencies received grant awards as outlined within Attachment A.
- **NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Memphis City Council does allocate \$2,600,000 in accordance with Attachment A as part of the Memphis City Council Grant Program for FY22.
- **THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the grant recipients must execute a contract with the City of Memphis Finance Division to receive the first disbursement equal to 50% of total grant award and submit a Mid-Year Report for the Council's review to receive second disbursement equal to 50% of total grant award.

Resolution requesting an exemption for a "smoke shop" regarding the 273-day moratorium on the issuance of permits for tobacco shops, head shops, smoke shops, and vape shops

WHEREAS, on February 23, 2021, the Council of the City of Memphis approved a resolution for a 273-day moratorium on the issuance of permits for tobacco shops, head shops, smoke shops, and vape shops; and

WHEREAS, as approved the resolution also requested that the Division of Planning and Development ("dpd") study the health, safety, welfare and secondary effects on schools, school-aged children and adjacent residential neighborhoods; it is understood that the study is underway pursuant to the request by the Memphis City Council; and

WHEREAS, the resolution further provided that exemptions be handled on a case-by-case basis through the adoption of exemption resolutions by the Memphis City Council"; and

WHEREAS, "CBD Smoke Shop Lounge LLC" seeks an exemption based on several factors including: this current shop is a relocation from another site open for one year; the lease for the new location was signed in September 2020; the shop is in a commercial shopping center (zoned CA) near the intersection of Kirby Parkway and Winchester Road with other commercial establishments in the vicinity selling smoke products; the owner of "CBD Smoke Shop Lounge LLC" started his codes permitting process in January 2021 and was issued a Certificate of Occupancy on 12 April 2021 on the condition that this smoke shop not sell tobacco or vape products; "CBD Smoke Shop Lounge LLC" has expended thousands of dollars on lease payments, build out, moving and stocking the new location; although "CBD Smoke Shop Lounge LLC" is allowed by Codes to open and sell CBD products only, it is not economically feasible to open without sales of a complete line of smoke products; (please see additional information contained in affidavit attached as Exhibit "A"); and

WHEREAS, the closest school to the subject site is more than one mile to the south on Kirby Parkway and the closest neighborhood is over 600 feet to the north; and

WHEREAS, "CBD Smoke Shop Lounge LLC" asserts that this business' operations strictly comply with all local, state and federal regulations regarding the storage and sale of smoke products and the owner has not been cited in violation of any such regulations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the owner of "CBD Smoke Shop Lounge LLC" respectfully requests an exemption from the 273-day moratorium on the issuance of permits for tobacco shops, head shops, smoke shops and vape shops and request the Memphis City Council to allow the owner (as attached in Exhibit "A") to fully open and operate the CBD Smoke Shop Lounge at 3562 Kirby Parkway, Memphis, Tennessee 38115 effective upon approval of resolution.

RESOLUTION TO PROVIDE CLARITY AND ALLOW FOR EXEMPTION REQUEST ON THE 245-DAY MORATORIUM FOR THE CONSTRUCTION AND OPENING OF ALL NEW GAS STATIONS AND USED TIRE SHOPS

WHEREAS, on March 16, 2021, the Memphis City Council passed a resolution requesting a 245-day moratorium on the construction and opening of all new gas stations and used tire shops; and

WHEREAS, the resolution expressly states that the moratorium would go into effect upon the adoption of the resolution; and

WHEREAS, this resolution is to clarify and define the meaning and intent of "construction and opening of all new gas stations and used tire shops;" and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Memphis City Council modifies and amends the moratorium to provide the following:

- 1. Construction and opening of all new gas stations and used tire shops does not include renovations to currently operating gas stations and used tire shops;
- 2. The moratorium does not apply to those that received a building permit, including any approved renewal obtained by the applicant prior to the expiration or termination of the permit to be renewed, on or before March 16, 2021; and
- 3. Potential applicants that fall under the moratorium may submit an exemption request along with a letter stating that a permit cannot be issued due to the moratorium to Councilwoman Logan. Councilwoman Logan will route the request to the Division of Planning and Development to determine applicability of the moratorium on the subject property.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the moratorium approved on March 16, 2021 is still in effect until November 16, 2021.

A resolution to allocate and appropriate \$200,000 to "A Cleaner Bluff City Initiative"

- **WHEREAS**, the Memphis City Council has made it a top priority to alleviate illegal dumping, address blight remediation, and beautify the entire Bluff City; and
- **WHEREAS**, everyone who lives, works, and visits the City of Memphis should enjoy clean public streets that are free from litter and debris; our quality of life, our economic prosperity, and our health are all tied to the cleanliness of our City streets, sidewalks, alleys, and other public spaces; and
- WHEREAS, "A Cleaner Bluff City Initiative" will focus on two specific areas within each single district: firstly, helping elderly citizens, with citations in Shelby County Environmental Court who qualify for a Solid Waste Reduced Fee Waiver based on income, who are unable to afford home repairs to address structural damage in order to bring homes up to code and make homes safe for habitation; and
- **WHEREAS,** secondly, "A Cleaner Bluff City Initiative" will focus on an additional quarterly cleaning of those illegal dumping "hot spots" in partnership with contractors to work with existing Divisions such as Public Works and the Public Service Corps in providing targeted clean-ups in the neighborhoods where they are most needed; and
- **WHEREAS**, these illegal dumping "hot spot" locations will be determined by the Director of Public Works using data to determine areas with the greatest need for additional quarterly cleaning within the seven single districts; and
- **WHEREAS,** all contracts greater than \$5,000.00 shall be selected in compliance with the Bidding Process outlined by the City of Memphis and ensuring MWBE participation; and
- WHEREAS, all applicants in the Bidding Process must meet the technical and compatibility requirements of the Divisions of Public Works and Public Service Corps; and
- **WHEREAS,** a robust partnership between the City, residents, businesses and community organizations will assist to improve the cleanliness of streets throughout the entire Bluff City to help reclaim the City's title as the "Nation's Cleanest City," which was earned and maintained during the later 1940s through the early 1950s.
- **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Memphis City Council does hereby support "A Cleaner Bluff City Initiative" to help alleviate illegal dumping, address blight remediation, and beautify the entire Bluff City by assisting elderly citizens with structural repairs to bring them up to code and identifying quarterly illegal dumping "hot spot" locations to provide additional targeted cleaning.
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Memphis City Council does hereby amend the budget to allocate and appropriate \$200,000.00 of the Council Community Impact Fund for Fiscal Year 2022 to create "A Cleaner Bluff City Initiative."
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Memphis City Council encourages all residents, businesses, and communities to work collaboratively to ensure City streets are clean for the safely, welfare, and health of all citizens of Memphis.
